COURSE OUTLINE

SUBJECT: Italian 1A

<u>Grade</u>: 6

Course Description

This course is a formal introduction to foreign language study. It sets the stage for all language skills for the beginning language learner, speaking, listening, reading, and writing. In addition, it fosters cultural understandings and includes age-appropriate communicative activities. The curriculum map for foreign languages in grades six through eight provides for a commonality of experiences for students regardless of their language choice. It is also referred to as "spiraling" in nature because most topics are introduced in the first year of instruction and become the basis for expansion in subsequent years.

- Use a strong basic vocabulary for personal expression(NYS 1; N1.1,5.1,5.2)
