

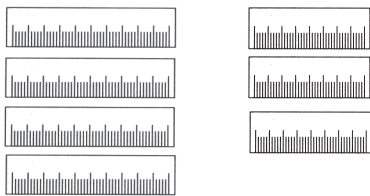
Unit 3 : Addition Within 10

Friendly Notes

Addition

Addition means **putting together**.

Let us make an addition story.



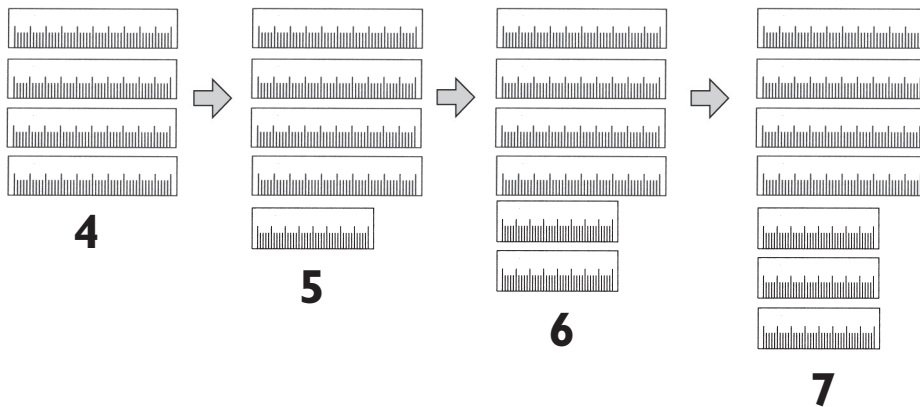
We put together
4 rulers and 3 rulers
to get 7 rulers.



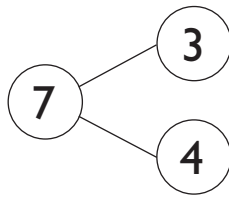
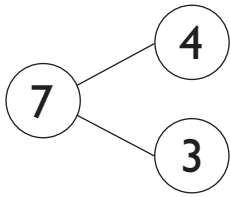
There are **4** long rulers.
There are **3** short rulers.
There are **7** rulers altogether.

We can count on to add the number of rulers.

Begin with 4 and count on to 5, 6, and 7.



We can use number bonds to show addition.



We write the addition equations:

$$4 + 3 = 7$$

$$3 + 4 = 7$$

Add 4 to 3.
Add 3 to 4.
The answer is 7.

We can also write this way:

$$7 = 4 + 3$$

$$7 = 3 + 4$$



$4 + 3 = 7$
“Four plus three equals seven.”

$3 + 4 = 7$
“Three plus four equals seven.”

So, $4 + 3 = 3 + 4$.

‘+’ means ‘add’.
‘=’ means ‘equal’.
