
Unit 9: Comparing Numbers

Friendly Notes

More or Less

We can compare numbers by counting, matching, or subtracting.



There are more bees than flowers.

There are **fewer** flowers than bees.

How many more bees than flowers are there? Let us subtract to find the answer.

There are 7 bees.

There are 5 flowers.

$$7 - 5 = 2$$

7 is 2 more than 5.

5 is 2 less than 7.


There are 2 more bees than flowers.

There are **2 fewer** flowers than bees.




2 more than 5 is 7.

$$5 + 2 = 7$$



2 less than 7 is 5.

$$7 - 2 = 5$$



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
