

2020-2021 School Health Requirements for New Students

- 1. New York State Law requires a physical examination for all students entering the school district.**
 - The physical exam must be completed by a licensed physician, physician assistant, or nurse practitioner authorized to practice in New York State.
 - The physical exam must be performed no more than one year prior to the new entrant's first day of school.
 - The physical exam form must be submitted to the Nurse's office within 30 days of the new entrant's first day of school.

- 2. New York State Law requires each student to be up to date with New York State Immunization Requirements for School Entrance and Attendance.**
 - The New York State Department of Health has not yet released the 2020-2021 School Year New York State Immunization Requirements for School Entrance/Attendance.

 - Proof of vaccination showing the student is up to date with NYS Immunization Requirements must be submitted to the Nurse's office within 14 days of the first day your child is in school.
 - Failure to comply within 14 days of the first day your child is in school is in violation of NYS Law and will be referred to the school administrator for exclusion from school.
- 3. A dental certificate which states your child has been seen by a dentist or dental hygienist is requested.** Click here for the [Dental Health Certificate](#).
- 4. Provider medication orders are required for any medication (both prescription and over-the-counter) held or given in school. Please be sure each form is completed in its entirety before leaving the doctor's office and before submitting to the Nurse's office.**
