## **Back-to-School Night!**

**September 10, 2025**

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Walk Through/ Locker Set Up**

Sixth grade students are invited to attend a “Walk Through” on Monday, August 25<sup>th</sup> (A-K) and Tuesday, August 26<sup>th</sup> (L-Z). During this time, students will assemble in the Commons (cafeteria) for a brief welcome and will then proceed upstairs to walk through their schedule, set up their lockers, and practice their locker combination. Student ambassadors will be there to help them along the way.

The schedule is as follows:

**August 25<sup>th</sup> Last Name: A – K**  
**10:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.**

**August 26<sup>th</sup> Last Name: L – Z**  
**10:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.**

### **New Hours for the Middle School**

Starting in the 2025-26 school year, the normal school day is from **8:00 a.m. – 2:50 p.m.** Additionally, there will only be 1 hr. early dismissal on Wednesdays on the following dates: 9/17/25, 11/19/25, 12/17/25, 1/14/26, 2/11/26, 4/22/26, 5/13/26, and 6/10/26.

### **Arrival / Dismissal**

Students will enter/ exit through the Middle School front doors. Doors open at 7:40 a.m. Drop off and pick up must happen in front of the Middle School only. This is for student safety. Please do not stop/ drop off in front of the High School.

## Lunch/ Recess

Students' lunch periods are divided between lunch and recess. Students visit the Commons (cafeteria) to eat/purchase food during their grade level lunch period and can also purchase breakfast before the start of the school day (8:00 a.m.). However, students are not permitted to go to the Commons during class or between classes. No food deliveries are allowed from restaurants, delis, coffee shops, etc. No food is allowed outside the Commons, and only water is allowed in the classrooms.

## Personal Electronic Devices

Per the NYS required policy, DFSD is restricting the use of personal electronic devices (cell phones, smartwatches, earbuds, and other non-school-issued devices) during the school day, including during recess and on-campus lunch periods. During school hours (8:00 a.m. - 2:50 p.m.) cell phones and other personal electronics must be turned off/silenced in the lockers or left at home. If your child needs to contact you or vice versa during school hours, our office staff is more than happy to help.

The first time a student uses a personal electronic device, an email or letter will be sent home to their parents. The consequences for repeat offenders are up to 5 days lunch detention and possible in-school suspension. Any devices found being used will be confiscated until the end of the day.

## Lockers/Backpacks

Lockers will be available for all middle school students. Backpacks will not be allowed in the classrooms and should stay in the students' lockers. Students will be taught how to use locker stops so they only take what they need to class. Rolling backpacks are not permitted without explicit permission. Students may use a cinch sac to carry their belongings from class to class.

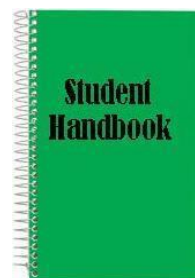


## Chromebooks

All students are issued a Chromebook and charger. While it is not the only tool used in the classroom, the Chromebook is an integral part of the teachers' pedagogy. It is the students' responsibility to bring their Chromebook to school every day, fully charged. Please remind your child that Chromebooks are to be used for academic purposes only. Chromebook insurance is encouraged for all students and is available for purchase on the school website.

## Student Handbook

The Dobbs Ferry Middle School Student Handbook can be found on the Middle School website. If you do not have access to a computer, hard copies are available in the Middle School Main Office. The purpose of this handbook is to help guide students and their families through their middle school years. It is designed to be "user-friendly" and answer many questions that middle school students and their families have about procedures, rules, regulations, and expectations. We ask that you take time to review the information in this handbook with your child and acknowledge with your signatures on the "Student Handbook Acknowledgement Form" on the Parent Portal.



## Google Classroom / Student Agenda

Students use Google Classroom to track and stay up to date with their assignments and classwork.

Student agendas will be distributed to **6<sup>th</sup> grade students only** as an additional organizational tool. These will be handed out at the beginning of the school year.



If your 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grader feels that a student agenda would be useful to them, they can pick one up in the Main Office. Supplies are limited however, so it will be first come, first serve, while supplies last.

## Parent Portal and E-Gradebook

All academic updates will be shared digitally, through the use of the Parent Portal. You will have access to your child's progress reports and report cards, as well as the ability to check your child's progress using the E-Gradebook feature. This feature will be updated approximately every two weeks by your child's teachers. Other important information available on the Parent Portal includes attendance, tardiness, and immunizations.
