## DFSD Recycle & Compost 2022-2023

<p><b><u>Recycle Plastic, Glass, Metal</u></b> <b>*Must be free of food</b></p> <p>Plastic with ♻️ #1-7 symbol only Milk &amp; juice boxes (empty) NO STRAWS Plastic water bottles (empty) with caps All aluminum cans (empty) Glass jars &amp; bottles (empty) with lids Aluminum foil &amp; aluminum to-go trays (free of food) Plastic hot/cold cup lids</p> <p>*If any item has food residue it cannot be recycled and must go in the trash!</p>	<p><b><u>Recycle Paper</u></b> <b>*Clean &amp; dry paper only</b></p> <p>All Paper (including shredded) Cardboard Newspaper &amp; magazines Pizza box (FREE of cheese/grease) Paper wrapper from drinking straws Empty toilet paper/paper towel <u>rolls</u> Greeting cards &amp; junk mail Cardboard sleeves for hot coffee cups</p> <p>*If paper has tape, glue or staples it must go in the trash!</p>
<p><b><u>Compost</u></b> ALL food scraps! (Fruit &amp; vegetable scraps, meat, dairy, bread, pizza, pasta, yogurt)</p> <p><b><u>Compostable Products *</u></b> Trays (clean and dirty) In-school paper products (paper bowls, paper plates, compostable utensils, to-go containers, cups, <u>paper</u> straws) Paper towels (free of soap/chemicals) Soiled pizza boxes <u>with</u> oils/cheese Clean or dirty napkins Non synthetic tea bags (no staples) Clean &amp; dirty napkins &amp; tissues</p> <p><i>* Must have a BPI symbol for certified compostable if from outside of school! Otherwise it goes in the trash!</i></p> <p><b><u>Liquid Bucket</u></b> Leftover milk, juice, water &amp; seltzer poured into a 5 gallon bucket for drain disposal. NO Straws, NO cereal</p>	<p><b><u>Trash</u></b> Snack wrappers, all chip bags <u>Plastic</u> utensils &amp; <u>plastic</u> straws Juice pouches &amp; straws All plastic bags (reuse first) All soft plastic wrap Ziploc bags Soft foil lids on yogurts Styrofoam/packing materials <u>Wax coated</u> plates, hot cups Hot coffee cups from outside school All wipes Fruit and vegetable stickers Laminating paper Shiny, metallic wrapping paper Wet paper that cannot be recycled Paper towels (with chemicals)</p> <p><b><u>Food Donations ♡:</u></b> Unopened snacks, packaged condiments, uneaten apples, bananas, sealed yogurt, milk,cheese sticks, crackers.</p>
