

- Chaperone to student ratio: Approximately 1:10
- Supervision: Tour with students or check in regularly
- Medication disbursement

Important Dates

- <u>November 2</u>: Registration form and first deposit of \$50 to secure seat on trip due.
- January 2: Payment #2 (if using payment plan)
- February 2: Payment #3 (if using payment plan)
- March 2: Payment #4 (if using payment plan)
- April 2: Payment #5 Final Payment due (if using payment plan)
- <u>May 20-May 23</u>: Bring in labeled medications
- June 5 June 7, 2019: Trip to Washington, DC

Medications:

- <u>ALL medications</u> both prescription and over-the-counter - require the *REQUEST FORM FOR ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION TO STUDENT IN SCHOOL* to be filled out.
- All medications must be <u>directly delivered</u> to the School Nurse 10 days prior to the trip, by a parent or guardian.
- All medications **MUST** be clearly labeled with the student's name, in the original package/bottle, with the appropriate dosage and administration time labeled
- Students <u>may not</u> carry medications or self-administer. Chaperones will carry all medications.

Field Trip Behavior Policy

When a student receives 3 disciplinary referrals, the student will be placed on trip probation and provided with a behavioral support plan.

Every student placed on probation has the opportunity to be taken off by adhering to the Code of Conduct.

Grade level teams will meet monthly to discuss each student's progress towards behavioral goals and possible removal from probation.

Academic Trip Probation

Students failing two or more courses will be placed on trip probation.

Students who remain on probation for academic and/or behavioral reasons will be prohibited from attending the DC trip.

*It should be noted that when an offense is deemed egregious by school administration, the consequence for such an offense will be determined solely at the discretion of the administrators.
