Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Dobbs Ferry Union Free School District offers an insurance plan for the Chromebooks lent by the District to students participating in the free and reduced meal program. The plan covers all accidental damage, loss and theft with no deductible. A loaner Chromebook will be provided while repairs are made.

The insurance will cover your child's Chromebook through the end of 12th grade. The cost of buying insurance per student is as follows:

- \$9.00 in 9th grade
- \$7.00 in 10th grade
- \$5.00 in 11th grade
- \$3.00 in 12th grade

Once insured, to report accidental damage to or loss or theft of a Chromebook, please bring the device to the High School main office and complete a Chromebook Repair Form.

Please note that should you choose not to participate in the Chromebook insurance plan you will remain responsible for any damage to or loss or theft of your child's Chromebook. Typical charges have ranged from \$50.00 to replace a cracked screen to up to \$300.00 to replace an irreparable, lost or stolen Chromebook.

To enroll in the plan:

- Complete the form below and return it along with payment to the High School main office on or before September 12, 2025. Please make checks payable to the Dobbs Ferry School District.


