

Important Information for School Budget Vote/Board of Education Elections

Dear Dobbs Ferry Community Members,

The coronavirus pandemic has greatly impacted voting procedures for the upcoming School Budget and Board of Education vote. Please read the information below to assure that your vote counts:

- Absentee Ballots will be mailed to all Dobbs Ferry registered voters on **Tuesday, May 26th**
- If you are registered with the county and DO NOT receive a ballot by **Monday, June 1st**, please contact District Clerk Loretta Tularzko by email at tularzkol@dfsd.org
- The Budget Newsletter will be posted to the District website www.dfsd.org and mailed out on **Wednesday, May 27th**. To see more detailed information on the proposed 2020-2021 Budget, go to the homepage and click in SpotLight
- **All Absentee Ballots must be returned to the School District by 5 PM on Tuesday, June 9th**. Ballots are to be returned in the stamped addressed envelope by mail. There will also be a **drop box on the day of the vote** (June 9th only) inside the High School door by the Business Office
- **PLEASE NOTE: June 9th is NOT a postmark date!** All Ballots must be received by that date to be counted. (You may also be receiving absentee ballots for other elections, including the June 23rd NY State elections. Review all voting materials carefully as these will have different dates and guidelines)
- Tune-in to the **Virtual Candidates Forum** for Dobbs Ferry's School Board Election sponsored by the League of Women Voters and Dobbs Ferry PTSA. There are 2 seats open and 3 candidates.
