Reminder:

You may make an appointment to register your child by calling the Springhurst Main Office at 914-693-1503 ext. 3. Kindergarten Registration will begin the week of March 7th 2022.

You will need the following to register your child:

- 1. Proof of your child's age. Please provide one of the following.
- Passport
- Birth Certificate
- 2. Three proofs of residency.

One of the following pertaining to a home in the District:

- A Mortgage or Closing Statement
- Deed
- A Notarized (by both landlord and lessee) Signed Lease
- A Notarized Rent Receipt

In addition, required in conjunction with the lease when the name on the lease is different from parent name and utilities are included in the rent, or in the absence of a lease:

• Affidavit of Property Owner/Landlord

In addition, copies of any two of the following documents must be submitted:

- Property Tax Bill
- Telephone Bill
- Gas & Electric Utility Bill
- Water Bill
- Driver's License/Picture ID
- Oil Company Bill
- Insurance Bill
- Bank Statement
- Voter Registration Card
- 3. Completed registration forms.

Prior to school entry:

Please notify the school nurse of any serious allergies or medical conditions your child may have.

Health Examination Form:

New York State law requires a physical examination and immunization record for all new or returning students to the District. This physical exam must be performed by a physician licensed in NY State or whose office is located within 50 miles of the state border. The physical must be done any time after September 6, 2021 and must be signed and stamped by your child's doctor.


Physical forms will be given at Kindergarten Registration or are available on the Dobbs Ferry District website (Departments; Health Services; NYS School Health Examination Form.)

Immunizations:

All children are required by NY State to have <u>ALL</u> the following immunizations <u>before entering school</u>:

- DTap/DTP/Tdap 5 doses
- Polio (OPV or IPV) 4 doses
- MMR 2 doses
- Hepatitis B 3 doses on proper schedule
- Varicella/Varivax (chicken pox) 2 doses

Physical and Immunization forms should be sent to the Health Office before August 1st, 2022 by mailing them directly to Springhurst Elementary School, 175 Walgrove Avenue, Dobbs Ferry, NY 10522. They can also be faxed to (914) 693-3188, emailed to the school nurses at dimariag@dfsd.org or cronink@dfsd.org, or dropped off in the main office at Springhurst. The school nurse will review and approve immunization records prior to enrollment of new students.
