The Committee asked Ron about the health insurance percentage and the ERS percentage. Ron reported the health insurance percentage reflects the new hires whose health insurance enrollments began with the September bill. He also noted that these numbers are slightly higher than previous years because of the number of new positions created in this year's budget. Ron also reported the ERS percentage is reflective of additional participants in the ERS system as compared to previous years. Ron will monitor ERS expenses to see if any budget transfer is necessary in the future.

Other

- The district received the first installment of the school tax payment from the Town of Greenburgh in the amount of approximately \$19.5 million.
- The district received approval for the Emergency Connectivity Fund grant in the amount \$69,900 which is to be used for mobile internet and one-one Chromebooks for students in need.
