Springhurst STEAM Program

- STEAM Science Technology Engineering Art Math
- Program started last year as a voluntary recess "alternative" for 4th grade students
- Focus on student inquiry, dialogue, and critical thinking
- Supporting students to become learners who take risks, engage in experiential learning, develop persistence when problem solving, and embrace collaboration
- 2-3 week sessions 25 minutes/day
- Approximately 75/110 students in grade 4 participated at some point
- Small group 12-15 students
- This year the program has been expanded to include 5th grade students as well
- Topics Include:
 - Anaglyph Technology
 - Electrical Circuits
 - OZO BOTS coding
 - Architecture
 - Stop Motion Video
 - Painting with light
- Faux Fossils Digital Art Kaleidoscopes Pendulum Painting Claymation Creating Short Videos
- Discussions are ongoing regarding ways in which the program might be expanded, and the feasibility of it being embedded within the school day
