Springhurst

ELA - Small group instruction will be a focus this year

Math - Pilot Math Programs-Illustrative Math/Invisions Math. Teachers from every grade level have volunteered to pilot different sections of the math program across all grades.

Our K-6 Math Coordinator, Josh Rosen, will move to K-8 to better support consistent math instruction K-8.

We will hire a .5 Math AIS teacher to replace some of Josh's role at Springhurst and support students receiving AIS services. We will be using grant money to fund this part-time position.

Darrell and Julia are looking into a system to collect and analyze data from the Math Pilot programs.
