## 2. 2019-20 Budget Development

- Enrollment Projections (see attached)
- Building Allocations
  - The amount of funds allocated to each building have been restored and/or increased. Also, the funds allocated per student have been equalized between Springhurst and the MS. The total budget impact is \$13,473.

• Also, library book allocations have been increased and equalized to \$20 per student. The total budget impact is \$8,989.
