3.01 Revised Revenue Budget for the 2023-2024 Budget

As the Board had discussed this possibility at the April 11 meeting, this additional aid will be used to offset the projected tax levy. The new projected tax levy increase is 3.59%, down from the earlier projection of 5.02%.
