

Indoor Mask-Wearing Requirement Remains in Effect through March 2, 2022

Late yesterday, the New York State Appellate Division granted the State's application for a stay pending hearing on the condition that the State submits its appellate brief on or before March 2, 2022. As a result, the requirement for all persons to wear masks in school buildings and on school buses remains in effect through March 2, 2022. However, it is important to note, the current regulation that requires masks to be worn indoors is set to expire on February 21, 2022. At this time, it is expected that the regulation will be extended.

Should there be any developments that would alter the indoor mask-wearing requirements, the school community will be notified.
