• NYS SCHOOL HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM (CURRENT PHYSICAL)

A physical exam is required for medical clearance. For the fall season ONLY any physical dated 2019 or 2020 will be accepted. Please upload the completed health examination form to FamilyID. (Note: It is important for parents to upload their child's health examination form as we do not have access to do so.)
