- **Photos:** take a photo and submit it to our secure database.
- Directory: school and teacher contact information (phone/email) and links to class pages.
- Forms: fill out forms and send them directly to our secure database.

"We are all excited about the potential of the app and our ability to further connect parents, students, and community members to the High School," said DFHS Principal John Falino. "A special thank you goes to the Dobbs Ferry PTSA for supporting the High School in this endeavor." Principal Falino reports that the new mobile app already has 800 downloads.

A committee including Principal Falino, Assistant Principal Candice Reim, Dean of Students Scott Patrillo, High School teachers and students researched and met with a number of mobile application developers this fall. They ultimately selected The App Developers to help design and host this latest technology tool. The App Developers offered an affordable iPhone and Android app technology specifically geared for K-12 schools. Other school districts such as Ossining, Briarcliff and Carmel are also using mobile apps to bridge the home-school communication gap.

These advances provide immeasurable opportunities for early adopters like the Dobbs Ferry School District, to effectively and efficiently expand their communications capabilities.
