Dobbs Ferry School District Welcomes New Assistant Superintendent for Finance, Facilities and Operations

Dobbs Ferry, N.Y. January 10, 2018—Ron Clamser Jr. officially joins the Dobbs Ferry School District on January 22, 2018 as the new Assistant Superintendent for Finance, Facilities and Operations. He is replacing Sylvia Fassler-Wallach, who was with the District for the past eleven years. Mr. Clamser’s appointment was approved by the Dobbs Ferry Board of Education at its January 9th meeting.

Since 2014, Mr. Clamser has been the Assistant Superintendent for Business and Human Resources for the Mahopac Central School District in Mahopac, New York. In that role, he oversaw the business office, transportation, technology, buildings and grounds, food services and most recently human resources. The Mahopac District comprises five schools, approximately 4,500 students and over 800 staff. Previously, Mr. Clamser was the School Business Executive for the Clinton-Essex-Warren-Washington BOCES in Plattsburgh, New York for four years, and prior to that, served as Business Manager for the Beekmantown Central School District in West Chazy, New York.

“Ron has a comprehensive understanding of school finance and human resources including budget development, recruitment and hiring, labor relations, financial reporting, audit compliance, and capital project management,” said Dobbs Ferry Superintendent of Schools Dr. Lisa Brady. “We are looking forward to having Ron on our team and as a member of our Dobbs Ferry family.”

Mr. Clamser graduated with a Master of Science Degree in Human Resource Management from SUNY Stony Brook; a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business-Accounting from the University of Phoenix in Tulsa, Oklahoma; and received an Associate Degree in Applied Science-Management from Oklahoma State University. He received his certification as a School District Business Leader from The College of Saint Rose in Albany, and is currently pursuing his Doctorate in Educational Leadership at Manhattanville College. He lives in Hopewell Junction with his wife and two children.

“I am very excited about this opportunity and getting to know the staff, parents and community members as we begin the budget building process for the next school year,” said Mr. Clamser. “I’m also looking forward to collaborating with the central office leadership team and using my experience in school finance, human resources and facility operations, to support the educational vision and mission of the Dobbs Ferry School District.”
