Dobbs Ferry High School Musical *The Addams Family* Garners Three METRO Awards Nominations

Dobbs Ferry, N.Y., May 19, 2017-- Dobbs Ferry High School's spring production of the musical *The Addams Family*, received three nominations for the prestigious METROS (Metropolitan High School Theater Awards), sponsored by *The Journal News* and Helen Hayes Youth Theatre. The Technical Merit award is a teacher-nominated honor given to students who show leadership and talent in any area of technical theater and senior **Ray Flaks**, Student Technical Director for the show, is one of the nominees.

"It's exciting to be receiving recognition for the first time entering these awards! It's also an honor to be nominated with the other outstanding productions in the Hudson Valley."
