


Inside Edition" on Education

uest children's book author Eric Bennett gave Springhurst Elementary School students a special preview of his latest picture book Noodfos' & Albie's Mermaid Parade, which will be published in early November. The book features the adventures of some loveable penguins and also happtms to be illustrated by former Springhurst student and Dobbs Ferry High School 2014 graduate Paige Monte. The students were excited to learn that Paige had won the 5th grade art award when she was at Springhurst, and her painting still hangs in the school's lobby today.



The most famous piece of writing advice ever given, "write what you know," is evident in this third *Noodles* & *Albie* adventure (the first two were named Mom's Choice Award winners) The Mermaid Parade is a real parade that takes place in Cooney Island and Noodles, the penguin protagonist



of the series, was Eric's nickname in school. Noodles also wears a baseball cap just like the author, and his fish friend Albie was modeled after a girl on his youth baseball team. His passion for penguins began as a-kid and he even owned an ii;ternet business that sold all things penguin.

Amazingly, the first time Eric and Paige met was the morning of the Springhurst presentation. They collaborated and communicated through email sending story/graphic treatments back and forth online. She and Eric had ben introduced through Paige's mother, a friend of the author. Paige was thrilled to be back at Springhurst where it all began, and equally excited to be starting a new job the very next week in NYC doing graphic animation at an ad agency. For Noodles and Paige this has been a wonderful story about friendships and coming of age.
