Students can purchase a second meal (\$1.25 for breakfast, \$2.75 for lunch) Adult meals are not free – Adults pay \$3 for breakfast and \$5.02 for lunch (plus tax on all adult purchases) Adult prices are tentative to change.

BREAKFAST: Breakfast will be served in the cafeteria from 7:40am – 9:00am.

LUNCH: Lunch will be served in the cafeteria from 11:04am -1:30pm

Please ensure students take a complete meal; otherwise, it will not be considered a free meal. A free meal consists of a Meat/Meat alternative, a Grain, and a Vegetable, Fruit, or Fruit Juice.
