To review student performance data from state and local assessments and identify gaps and underperformance of subgroups to review associated action steps/plans. 3. To review the implementation of the IB DP and MYP programs and the impact on student access and success. 4. To periodically review any challenges to instructional or library materials. 5. To monitor the implementation of Illustrative Math so as to determine if additional resources/support are needed for successful teaching and learning. 6. To monitor the Graduation Measures Project from NYSED to determine what, if any, steps the District should consider in response to policy changes.
